



DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE 15TH JUDICIAL COURT **SERVING ACADIA, LAFAYETTE & VERMILION PARISHES**

During the week of February 5, 2018 the following defendants were convicted or pled guilty to various charges and were sentenced in the 15th Judicial District Court, Parishes of Lafayette.

LAFAYETTE PARISH:

- 1. Darren Henderson, pled guilty to Unauthorized Entry, Simple Battery and Illegal Carrying of a Weapon, and was sentenced to 2 years hard labor with 2 years active supervised probation.**
- 2. Brayton Lietner, pled guilty to Simple Burglary, and was sentenced to 4 years hard labor with credit for time served.**
- 3. DeJaun Elay, pled guilty to Aggravated Battery, in which a Presentence Investigation Report was order.**
- 4. Brandon Broussard, pled guilty to Unauthorized use of a Moveable and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor, credit for time served.**
- 5. Derrious Williams, please guilty to Second Degree Battery and Simple Criminal Damage to Property, and was sentenced to 2 years hard labor and 2 years active supervised probation.**
- 6. Brenda Lee Moore, pled guilty to Simple Burglary of an Inhabited Dwelling, and was sentenced to 4 years hard labor.**
- 7. Carl Smith, pled guilty to Molestation of a Juvenile and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor.**
- 8. Felton Carter, pled guilty to Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon; Aggravated Flight and Simple Escape, and was sentenced to 11 years hard labor.**

The above cases were prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Cynthia Simon and Royale Colbert. Presiding over these matters was the Honorable Judge Edward Rubin.
