



DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE 15TH JUDICIAL COURT **SERVING ACADIA, LAFAYETTE & VERMILION PARISHES**

During the week of January 29, 2018 the following defendants were convicted or pled guilty to various charges and were sentenced in the 15th Judicial District Court, Parishes of Lafayette.

LAFAYETTE PARISH:

- 1. Lane Tylock, pled guilty to Carjacking and was sentenced to 3 years hard labor with 2 years without benefit of suspension of sentence.**
- 2. Jim Davis, pled to Domestic Abuse Aggravated Battery and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor, suspend all but 1 year, and 3 years active supervised probation.**
- 3. Charles Mouton, pled to Attempted Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor.**
- 4. Christopher Hebert, pled to Criminal Mischief and was sentenced to 3 months parish jail.**
- 5. Elton Vaughn, pled to Criminal Mischief and was sentenced to 6 months parish jail.**
- 6. Lorenzo Richard, pled to 2nd Offense Domestic Abuse Battery and was sentenced to 1 year hard labor.**
- 7. Cory Bourque, pled to Theft under \$750 and was sentenced to 6 months parish jail, suspended, 12 months supervised probation.**

The above cases were prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Daniel M. Landry, III and Alan Haney. Presiding over these matters was the Honorable Judge David Smith.
