



DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE 15TH JUDICIAL COURT **SERVING ACADIA, LAFAYETTE & VERMILION PARISHES**

On February 1, 2018 the following defendants pled guilty to various charges and were sentenced in the 15th Judicial District Court, Parishes of Lafayette.

LAFAYETTE PARISH:

- 1. Claire Doucet, pled guilty to Identity Theft and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor, all but 1 year suspended and 3 years probation.**
- 2. Arture Salas-Carlos, pled guilty to Indecent Behavior with a Juvenile, and was sentenced to 1 year and 1 day, and was deported.**
- 3. Robert Lee Leblanc, pled guilty to Simple Burglary of an Automobile, and was sentenced to 4 years hard labor and 2 years active supervised probation.**
- 4. Devonte Wright, pled go Aggravated Assault with a Firearm and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor, 1 year suspended and 3 years probation.**
- 5. Preston Fuselier, pled to Second Degree Battery, and was sentenced to 4 years hard labor all but 1 year suspended and 3 years active supervised probation.**
- 6. James Williams, pled go Simple Burglary of an Automobile, and was sentenced to 4 years hard labor and 2 years active supervised probation.**
- 7. Jim Davis, pled to Domestic Abuse Aggravated Assault, and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor, suspend all but 1 year and 3 years active supervised probation.**
- 8. Lane Tylock, pled guilty to Carjacking, and was sentenced to 3 years hard labor 2 years without suspension of sentence.**
- 9. Charles Mouton, pled to Attempted Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, and was sentenced to 5 years hard labor.**
- 10. Antonio Lewis, pled to Attempted Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, and was sentenced to 3 years hard labor.**

The above cases were prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Daniel M. Landry III and Alan Haney. Presiding over these matters was the Honorable Judge David Smith.
