



DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE 15TH JUDICIAL COURT **SERVING ACADIA, LAFAYETTE & VERMILION PARISHES**

District Attorney Keith Stutes announces the conviction of Albert Kirk Sampy of the offenses of Vehicular Homicide and Negligent Injury in the 15th Judicial District Court on November 27, 2017 in Lafayette Louisiana.

On April 24, 2016, Albert Kirk Sampy, while operating a Motor Vehicle under the influence of alcohol and after having also been convicted twice before of the offense of Driving While Intoxicated, struck a vehicle head-on while travelling on University Avenue. The vehicle was occupied by a Mother and her 10 year old child. The crash caused the death of the young child and seriously injured the Mother.

Sampy received the maximum sentence of 30 years on the Vehicular Homicide and 15 years on the Negligent Injury.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Roya Boustany and was investigated by the Lafayette Police Department Officer Michael Starling.

Judge Patrick Michot presided over the matter.
