



## **DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE 15TH JUDICIAL COURT** **SERVING ACADIA, LAFAYETTE & VERMILION PARISHES**

**On July 11, 2018, Brook Dale Boudreaux was sentenced to 10 years hard labor, without parole, after pleading guilty to possession of a a firearm by a convicted felon.**

**A Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for crossing the centerline in the early morning hours of October 4, 2016. Before coming to a complete stop, the driver fled on foot, leaving behind a pistol in the console. The Sheriff's deputy and witnesses identified Brook Boudreaux as the driver of the vehicle.**

**The Acadiana Crime Lab analyzed DNA samples from the recovered pistol as well as the defendant's DNA and determined Boudreaux was the source of the DNA found on the pistol.**

**The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Robert Odinet. Presiding over the case was Judge Marilyn Castle.**
