



## **DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE 15TH JUDICIAL COURT** **SERVING ACADIA, LAFAYETTE & VERMILION PARISHES**

The Domestic Abuse Division for Lafayette Parish announces the conviction of Jared Sarver for Domestic Abuse Battery on January 29, 2019 after a bench trial before Judge John Trahan. Judge Trahan sentenced Sarver to five months parish jail.

On October 6, 2016, Sarver and the victim were living together. After a verbal altercation, Sarver lunged at the victim, grabbed her by the throat and pushed her against the wall. At the time of the incident, Sarver was on probation for a Simple Burglary involving a previous domestic partner. As a result of this conviction Sarver now faces serving five years hard labor on his probated sentence.

The case was prosecuted by Emila S. Pardo and investigated by the Lafayette Police Department.
