Acadia Parish Conviction

An Acadia Parish jury convicted 28-year-old Joshua Lynn White of Rayne, Louisiana of Possession with intent to Distribute Marijuana in the 15th Judicial District Court before Judge Laurie Hulin on September 25, 2019.

White has five prior convictions consisting of Attempted Entry into an Inhabited Dwelling, Simple Burglary, Distribution of Cocaine, Theft of an Automobile and Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon. The trial began on September 24, 2019. The jury heard from investigating officers with the Acadia Parish Sheriff's Office, and personnel from the Acadiana Crime Lab.

A sentencing date will be scheduled after a pre-sentence investigation is complete.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Jack E. Nickel. The case was investigated by the Acadia Parish Sheriff's Office under the supervision of Detective Karen Matthews.
